What is an Eco Sangha?

The Eco Sangha was founded to promote the awareness that to be a Buddhist is automatically to be an Ecologist and a Conservationist. This view of Buddhism goes beyond sectarian differences and can act as a unifying force for dynamic Buddhist conservation efforts.

Shin Buddhism has some rather unique perspectives which are reflected in the Japanese expression "Mottainai (Wastefull)" which lies at the heart of the BCA National Council "Eco Sangha Resolution" which was passed in 2015.
